Bass/ Wilson to approve the March 25, 2025 agenda. Ayes-five. Motion carried.

Bass/Rodden to open the Public Hearing for the purpose of considering the maximum tax dollars from certain levies for the city's proposed fiscal year 2025/2026 budget at 5:01 p.m. Ayes-five. Motion carried. City Clerk Eastman stated the proof of publication is on file and there was no public comment received. Chad Schwickerath of 101 Elk Run Street brought up concerns of residents with a fixed income, mentioning the percentage of increase. Mayor Smock explained that the percentage isn't the increase itself, the actual increase is 1.19%, but the number on the forms is the percent of increase. Schwickerath continued to discuss his dislike of the utility bill cost. Holly Schwickerath stated she would like to see the city's budget. Smock informed her she can view it at city hall or on the state website. Schwickerath also complained about getting sidewalks and the use of their side yard for equipment. Wilson/Rodden motion to close the public hearing at 5:16 p.m. Ayes-five. Motion carried.
